Aims of the project:

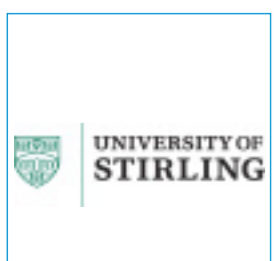
- To analyse and implement the outcomes of previous international projects in 6 core e-learning areas (thematic groups of the project)

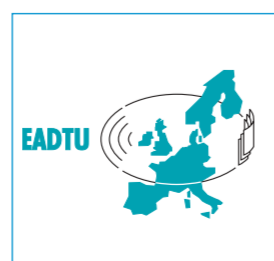

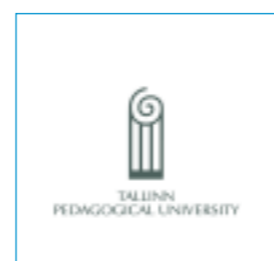
